

Instructions for Filling Out the Front Side of the Graduation Plan (for the Major)

On the front side of the Graduation Plan you indicate which ten courses you have and/or will take to complete the 30 hours required for the Film Studies major.

You list the courses you plan to take as well as the ones you have already taken. What you may actually take will in the end almost certainly be different from those you list now. In other words, you are not committing yourself to have to take the courses listed on the Plan.

What is important is that the courses you list (30 hours, 10 courses) complete the specific requirements. Make sure that there is the right number of courses in each category (3 "Required" courses, and 2 each in "National Cinema" and "Theory and Methods"). And check the Capstone Course. The others are electives. Of course, the electives may come from one of the required categories as well.

You indicate the courses by putting a check in the "Advising" column on the right. For those courses that are not listed, fill in the number and title on one of the blank lines and check the column on the right (there should be 10 checks in that column). For the courses at the bottom listed only by number, circle a course number and put a check out in the column for each course.

Note: Only Regular on-campus courses are accepted as counting toward the Film Studies major or minor, the Mizzou Online self-paced courses will not count toward either.
